Credential Type	Description	
Graduate Diploma	A program of study with a minimum of 30 credits of coursework at the 5000 level, and requires a minimum entrance requirement of Bachelor's degree.	
PostBaccalaureate Diploma	A program of study with a minimum of 60 credits, including a minimum of 30 credits of upper level courses (3000/4000 level courses), and requires a minimum entrance requirement of a Bachelor's degree.	
PostDegree Diploma	A program of study with a minimum of 30 credits, including a minimum of 15 credits of upper level courses (3000/4000 level courses), and requires a minimum entrance requirement of a Bachelor's degree.	
Training Group Certificate of Completion	Issued when a formal recognition of ses sful completion for a Training Group nore redit program is required. Appropriate evaluation of learning outcomes is planned and conducted.
