- 1. The early childhood educator works cooperatively with others (both children and adults) as listener, communicator, supporter, facilitator, guide and problem solver. The development of effective skills for relating interpersonally is essential to becoming a reflective practitioner.**

By observing and assessing children on a regular basis, the early childhood educator is able to plan a program that is age-appropriate, culturally sensitive, and able to meet the individual needs and interests of each child in inclusive early childhood programs. Regular observation and documentation also provide information about each child's development - information which is shared with the family.**
